Facility Background

For almost 100 years, Kerr-McGee and its predecessors treated railroad ties at the Facility at 2800 W. High St., leading to creosote-related contamination in the soil and groundwater at and around the Facility. The Multistate Trust has been prioritizing evaluating the off-Facility migration of contaminants that may potentially affect the surrounding community.
